Tim started putting his foundation together in the last weeks of November 2015. Writing the website and making the youtube movie he did without any help from any of us. He told us parents and brother on December 1st 2015 that he wanted to leave us a foundation with only one goal! Find a cure for synovial Cell Sarcoma. He launched the website on the December 2nd.

To make September a special month, to raise awareness for Childhood Cancer Awareness Month. We were able to put together the grant comity for LFOF!

In the last couple of months we received 3 proposals from researchers, who are willing to focus their research project completely on Synovial Cell Sarcoma! This is a milestone!! Nobody has done this before and focus so far has only been on just all sarcomas in general.

The LFOF grant comity is in the process of approving 1 and most likely 2 grants of \$50,000 for 2 research projects. Our goal is to make this decision before November 2016!

We are so thankful for all donations from each of you! In only 8 months we were able to raise \$126,000! An amazing amount! As most of you know, to reach our goal, we need many more dollars to reach LFOF goal!
